- Procurement of consultant for Development of the improved MIS system with support from UNICEF has been concluded.
- Contract signed with Advanced Geospatial Solutions (AGS) on 8th June 2020.

Development of MIS for sanitation still at infancy stage

- ✓ Pre-inception meetings have been held with MoWE and MoH
- ✓ AGS was introduced to the key contact persons,
- ✓ AGS presented their rough understanding of the task and general plans
- ✓ Scoping by the Consultant is ongoing to gather user requirements
- ✓ Consultative meetings with key contact persons are ongoing

Related activities / processes

- Dissemination of sanitation monitoring indicators and measurement framework to districts and CSOs with support from PLAN Uganda was done in 3 districts of Kamuli, Nebbi and Buyende and is still on-going.

- Delays in the procurement process due to COVID 19
- Limited Financial Resources to support dissemination of the performance measurement framework and monitoring indicators
