Progress in achieving outputs

- Working modality:
 - CCD developed the National Climate Change Mainstreaming Guidelines (2014)
 - Update the 2014 guidelines
 - Shared guidelines with sectors
- Interest Partners to support the mainstreaming process:
- Boardroom trainings to sectors in cc mainstreaming including DLGs
- TORs for the specific guidelines developed

Planned Actions and progress

- Random acts/responses! MAAIF
- Climate Change working groups formed by sectors (Agriculture, Energy, Water, Infrastructure)
- 1 out of 4 highly climate sensitive sectors developed their sector guidelines (Agriculture)
- Districts trained in processes (vs actual mainstreaming) not actual mainstreaming 38 out of 114 District Local Governments (DLGs)

Related activities / processes

- Complimentary & on going processes include:
- NDP 3 integration of climate change FAO supported
- On going Training on the use of the Climate & Disaster Risk Screening Tool with support from World Bank and budget tagging process
- Digital repository (e-library) was developed and Uganda National CC mainstreaming guidelines are on the CCD website www.ccd.go.ug

Key Challenges

- Process vs action: Passive trainings while necessary is not complete without actual mainstreaming/hands on taking place in all entities at National and Subnational
- Limited resources to implement the guidelines
- Timing?
- Gap in raising awareness on CC mainstreaming guidelines

Next Steps

- As an entry point perhaps update the 2014 guidelines
- Develop capacity building plan for training at the level of planners and practitioners for priority sectors/LG
- Develop training manual and modules on screening tools; and offline demo version
- Hands-on dedicated training and clinics on mainstreaming process and implementation

Next Steps

- Intensify boardroom meetings especially with MFPED and all sectors including DLGs
- Unmatched call in budget call circular vs execution?
- Reinvigorate the support for JPF 2
- Continued underscoring of mainstreaming process as an unfunded priority
