## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (EOI)

- 1. The Government of the Republic of Uganda represented by Ministry of Water and Environment through the Climate Change Department has allocated funds towards the cost of undertaking Consultancy Services for Preparation of Uganda's Second Biennial Update Report to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.
- 2. The overall objective of the assignment is to Prepare Uganda's Second Biennial Update Report to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.
- 3. The Ministry of Water and Environment now wishes to invite eligible Consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services and relevant experience to execute the required scope of services.
- 4. The short-listing criteria will include: Experience in at least 2 comparable assignments of a similar nature and magnitude (attach completion certificates and contract agreements).
- 5. Successful bidders should not have conflict of interest in relation to the subject of the procurement, should not be suspended by PPDA, and must demonstrate legal capacity to contract. Bidders should also provide a cover letter, Organisational structure indicating number and qualifications of personnel, valid trading license, Certificate of Incorporation, Memorandum and Articles of Association, company profile, evidence of being a local provider. "Local provider" means a provider registered in Uganda whose majority ownership is held by Ugandan citizens. Documents to be submitted in the bid as proof of eligibility to be a local provider include; Return of Allotment of Shares; and copies of the national identity cards or passports of the majority shareholders. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-contract to enhance their qualifications. The form of association, where applicable, should be indicated in the Expression of Interest.
- 5. A consultant will be selected in accordance with Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in PPDA Regulations of Uganda, 2014. Exclusive Reservation by threshold to local providers shall apply. Only firms with demonstrated experience in similar assignments will be shortlisted.

- 7.
