Critical challenges and Practical Solutions

Critical challenge	Practical solutions
Low access to safely managed sanitation	Develop a sector plan for accelerated access Promotion of whole service chain (containment, emptying and transportation, treatment, re-use)
Limited sector budget appropriation to sanitation	Improve sector allocation to sanitation activities
Limited technological options	Promote appropriate/innovative technology options for different settings; eg compact systems for estates
Institutional collaboration	Strengthen the National Sanitation Working Group Strengthening governance and political commitment, e.g. KCCA's Majors Network for WASH

Critical challenge	Practical solutions
Operation and maintenance challenges	Finalize the undertaking on FSM management
Sanitation regulatory framework	Finalize standards review Disseminate sanitation regulation framework
Monitoring & evaluation framework	Disseminate the sanitation monitoring indicators, measuring framework and develop an improved data capture and reporting system (digital based)
Inadequate physical planning	Collaborate with Local Governments for inclusion of sanitation infrastructure

Proposed undertakings

- Develop a management framework for fecal sludge service chain (including business aspects) by end of FY 2019/20 (continued from last FY)
- Disseminate the sanitation monitoring indicators, measuring framework and develop an improved MIS system (digital based) by FY 2020/21
- Develop a national masterplan for improved coverage of “safely managed” sanitation by FY 2019/20
